The Court do order, That the s^d Hannah do for the future no more cohabit wth. s^d Josiah Owen, or have fellowship with him as with an husband, and that she make a publick acknowledgement of her sin & evil before the Congregation at Braintree on their Lecture day, or on the Lords day.
